## NOTICE: CDBG SURVEY TO BE CONDUCTED

On **January 25-26**, the City of Randolph will have a contracted survey crew conducting a survey of residents to obtain information to determine eligibility for the City to apply for grant programs to help with the cost of improvements to the City's water distribution system.

The City desires to apply for grant funds to help finance the construction of improvements to the water distribution system. The grant, if approved, would help pay for a portion of the project costs. A grant, as opposed to a loan, would not have to be paid back by the City. If the City receives the grant, the total cost of the project will not have to be raised through rate increases or other revenues.

The survey will involve the following general questions:

- Question pertaining to the support for the project.
- Question pertaining to water quality and water quality issues experienced at your residence.
- Question asking whether the total household income is above or below a set dollar amount depending on family size.

The questions regarding the income of the household are VERY IMPORTANT and will determine eligibility for the grant programs and are critical to the success of the application. Program guidelines require this information to be a part of each application. If the incomes of a majority of individuals in the survey are higher than the median income limits the City will not be eligible for the grant programs.

The surveys are completely CONFIDENTIAL and do not need to be signed. All information is totally anonymous and only the collective summary data is used for reporting purposes.
